- Inform, educate, and empower: Inform, educate, and empower people about health issues.
- Mobilize community partnerships: Mobilize community partnerships and action to identify and solve health problems.
- Develop policies: Develop policies and plans that support individual and community health efforts
- Enforce laws: Enforce laws and regulations that protect health and ensure safety.
- Link people: Link people to needed personal health services and assure the provision of health care when otherwise unavailable.
- Assure competent workforce: Assure competent public and personal health care workforce.
- Evaluate: Evaluate effectiveness, accessibility, and quality of personal and population-based health services.
- Research: Research for new insights and innovative solutions to health problems.

While knowledge about the basis of public health services is essential to solving community health problems, a shift in the mind-

set of individuals - particularly in the area of lifestyle - is pertinent to mitigate global health challenges. It is time we exposed and explored the undeniable linkage between public health issues and individual behaviour.

Tony Blair, the Prime Minister of Britain, aptly summarized this in 2006 with the following words, "We are now in a new era, the time of conditions of affluence, of degenerative and man-made diseases... Our public health problems are not, strictly speaking, public health questions at all. They are questions of individual lifestyle obesity, smoking, alcohol abuse, diabetes, sexually transmitted disease". Knowing this, which path shall we tread as individuals?
