Algeria is located in northern Africa, and is the largest country in the continent in terms of area. Its large area enabled it to diversify the vegetation cover and therefore animal.

Animals are distributed according to regions. We find in the north where the vegetation cover is dense and the presence of animals such as (cows, sheep, horses, goats). In the south, where the vegetation cover is less (thorny plants) (the desert) we find animals such as (camels and sheep) especially the ouled djellel in Biskra, which is considered one of the finest breeds in the world.

Despite the dependence of the Algerians people on raising animals (cows, sheep) as a source of livelihoods. However, the state does not give enough importance to the specialization of veterinary medicine.

For example, veterinary students face a problem with the language, as they study at the university in French, which is not the mother tongue in the country.

It is not possible to talk about the state of the veterinarian in Algeria as a whole we are satisfied with taking a place only (a sample), for example, the Ben Azzouz region, most of the population practices the profession of animals husbandry, whether cows and sheep destined for consumption (meat) or milks-producing cows in addition to raising chickens in the units.

There are many diseases in the region including:

- Fasciola hepatica
- Blue pitch
- Babesiosis
- Symptomatic anthrax
- Foot-and-mouth disease

Where the veterinarian moves to the animal and it is treated. In addition to surgical operations (cesarean birds) are transported to clinics.

The state is working to improve the cow breeds by placing reinforcements for farmers to develop the field.
